Congressman Mark Amodei (R-NV) Biography



Rep. Mark Amodei was first elected to serve Nevada's second district in a special congressional election in 2011.

Amodei was born in Carson City, Nevada on June 12, 1958. He attended Carson High School and graduated in 1976. After graduation from high school, Amodei was a student at the University of Nevada, Reno where he graduated with a BA in 1980 and later received his law degree from the University of Pacific's McGeorge Law school in 1983.

When Amodei passed the bar exam, he became an Army Judge Advocate General's Corps officer. During his four years of military service, he was awarded the Army Achievement Medal, the Army Commendation Medal and the Meritorious Service Medal. Immediately after receiving an honorable discharge, Amodei returned to Carson City and worked for multiple firms over the course of twenty years before becoming a sole practitioner in 2009.

Before his election to Congress Amodei served two years as a member of the Nevada State Assembly and a dozen years as a member of the Senate, where he was president pro tempore. He has served on the Legislative Commission, Vice Chair of the Governor's Task Force on Access to Public Health Care, Education Commission of the States, Public Lands committee, the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency Legislative Oversight committee, Chairman of the Education Technology committee, and was a member of the Nevada Supreme Court's committee on Court Funding.

After his time in the Nevada Senate, Amodei was the chairman of the Nevada Republican Party before stepping down to run for Congress. He was elected to the 112th Congress.
