


GMR Veterans ERG

Chair - This is the individual who leads the ERG and oversees all its activities. Expected to coordinate the meeting agenda with the admin support, gathering and reviewing all updates from team members and committee leads to produce a fruitful TEAM meeting and ALL HANDS meeting. This role rotates between three people (Chair & Co-Chairs) every four months. 1-year commitment with an optional six month transition period as Past-Chair.

Past-Chair - Previous years Chairperson (1 of the 3) who stays on for six months to assure continuity of the ERG activities.

Co-Chairs (2) - This person is responsible for assisting the Chairperson and stepping in when needed. This role rotates between three people (1 Chair & 2 Co-Chairs) every four months.

Admin Support Liaison - Person whose SME is organization related to meetings, action items and project planning.

Marketing/Comms Liaison – This person would be the conduit between the ERG and the Marketing team. This individual is responsible for leading the ERG’s communications, such as newsletters, social media and email updates.



IT/Platform Liaison – One member accountable for establishing a platform that is easy to interface with. The platform will enable successful activities at the BU level.

DE&I Liaison – One member accountable to keep a pulse on the National DE&I resources that elevate this ERG team's mission. Promote and advocate for diversity and inclusion within the Military ERG.
