




Thank you for attending the 31st Annual GMR Foundation for Research and Education Golf Tournament.

By participating, you help to further our mission to support clinical, education and health systems research designed to improve the care and safety of patients in the out-of-hospital setting. The GMR Foundation supports research and educational activities within clinical practices, and promotes initiatives focused on improving patient care and projects which contribute directly or indirectly to the health and well-being of communities.

The Golf Tournament began 31 years ago with the goal of generating funds and in-kind donations, enabling paramedic training programs to acquire expensive, state-of-the-art medical technology. Now, the golf tournament has become an integral part of the GMR Foundation for Research and Education. Because of your generous support last year, we were able to provide grants, funding and scholarships to a number of organizations and individuals.





Distributed \$107,900 in institutional scholarship grants to eight EMT and paramedic training institutions; funds were distributed to financially struggling students.

Provided \$16,465 in research funding for continuing education and professional development opportunities for physicians and front-line EMS providers at the UCLA Prehospital Care Research Forum (PCRF) and ESO® Research Forum.

Provided \$35,000 in EMS professional development scholarships, where 75 recipients received funding to attend the National Association of EMS Physicians® (NAEMSP) Annual Meeting.

Provided \$20,000 for NAEMSP EMS Fellow Research projects.


